









Unit 1 TEACHER POSSIBLE FEEDBACK PHRASES & NOTES ON CHILDREN

At this point in the programme, we encourage you to stick to positive feedback. Where possible, we are trying to encourage confident and relaxed conversation. Below are examples if you are unsure how to phrase this. There is space on this form to record if you notice that particular children are struggling.

LO	POSSIBLE FEEDBACK PHRASES	NOTES ON SPECIFIC CHILDREN
Chatting is Teamwork	 I liked that you paid attention to what your partners said.  I liked that you helped keep the chat going.	
People chat in different ways	 It was great that you encouraged [QUIET CHATTING PARTNER] to join in.  It was great that you had one or two really thoughtful things to say about (example of topic)  It was great that you said something really funny about the topic (give example)	
Showing interest	 You did a great job of using <i>Interested Supporting Words</i> (provide example e.g. 'wow' / 'yuk') so your chat partner knew you were interested.  You looked like you were really interested in what each other was saying	
General positive feedback	 I liked that you were friendly and smiling at your partner during the chat
